


# How to Add a New Client to the Leader CSP Portal for Microsoft Licensing

# Accessing the Leader Systems Cloud Portal




#### **Adding Licenses**

Search for the licenses you need or select from the options available at the bottom of the page.

Click on Add Licenses and proceed to Check Out.






#### Setting Up a New Customer

On the next screen, choose New Customer.

Fill in the client's name but use your reseller information to ensure clients cannot be contacted by Microsoft directly.


Click Save and then Next. This will take you to the Service Details screen, where you can link with the client's M365 admin portal.




## Verifying Domain Details

Enter the domain prefix, which can be found in the client's admin portal by navigating to Settings > Domains. For example, 360business.on.microsoft with the default domain being 360business.com.au.





After entering these details, click Verify. A pop-up will request the default domain on the client's account. Enter the default domain here (e.g., 360business.com.au).






# \*IF there is no current M365 Tenancy and a new one is required

When entering the new company's details, be sure to use the domain the business already owns. This action will initiate the creation of a new Microsoft Tenancy, assigning a unique address in the format of yourcompany.onmicrosoft.com. After completing the licensing order, you will receive an email containing the login credentials for this new tenancy.

# Finalizing the Process

Wait for a few moments as it connects to the client's portal. Once connected, you will be taken to the final screen.



Allow 1-5 minutes for the licenses to appear in the client's M365 portal.
